As the spring season approaches, here are some important updates and events happening in our community:

#### 1. Important Reminders

- **HOA Dues**: HOA dues statements were sent out in February. Dues for 2025 have increased by \$10 per year to \$175 to cover increased operating costs. Timely payments help us maintain and improve our community.
- **Property Improvements:** Please remember to submit a request prior to starting any new projects or improvements. For more information, visit <u>Property Improvements</u>.
- Safety Concerns: Do not park on Austin's Colony Parkway to pick up or drop off children for Sam Rayburn Intermediate School.
- Tree Replanting: Winter is a good time to replant trees after the recent droughts.
- Lawn Maintenance: Lawn maintenance is our number one violation, including mowing and weed control. Please ensure your lawns are maintained.
- Traffic Reminder: Many questions have come in about right-hand turns from Austin's Colony Parkway center lane to William Joel Bryan Parkway. This is legal and marked on signs and pavement.
- **Pet Reminder:** Please remember to keep pets leashed when outside of a secure enclosure. Additionally, kindly clean up after your pets to help maintain a clean and pleasant community for all.

#### 2. New Fine Schedule

The HOA has adopted a new fine schedule to ensure compliance with community rules and regulations. The updated fine schedule took effect on January 1st, 2025.
